

The 3, 2, 1 of Getting All Members Involved in a Club Event

- 1. Appoint a member to chair event.
- 2. Chair/Committee develop a member resume (or tweak the one on the Nebraska District Website).
- 3. Ask each member to complete resume.
- 4. Schedule a presentation for each meeting or at least one per month.
- 5. Chair asks a member to read resume to Club.
- 6. Club members try to guess the member whose resume is being read.
- 7. Member who guesses the name of the member recieves a small prize.
 - Ideas: something goofy, \$10 gift card to local restaurant, Optimist Club swag, etc
- 8. Member whose resume was read (this person should be asked beforehand if they will be attending and willing to participate) will then stand and tell a little more about themselves such as how long they have been an Optimist member, offices they have held, etc.
- 9. Time is not an issue as this exercise should take about 5 minutes from meeting agenda.
- 10. Clubs of almost any size can do this and get more people involved interacting with each other which hopefully will extend to community projects and activities the Club may have in the future.
